Tasting Notes:

A complex bouquet of cedar smoke and graphite mingles with ripe fruit. It's full bodied on the palate and immediately fills the senses with notes of leather, blackberries, plums, and charred earth. The finish is long, tannic, and hints minerality.

Musty smoky spice overtones lead to notes of black cherry and licorice, with hints of iron, black tea, and charred bacon coming up on the finish. Lush and primary, but not dense, with nice fruit transparency.

Spice and red fruit aromas abound on the pungent nose. Deep flavors of currants and blackberries are ripe and supple on the palate. Powerful earthiness and cocoa powder mix with hints of dried plum on the leathery and rustic finish.

Tasting Notes:

Bursting forth with vivid lemon zest, geranium, and vine sap aromas, this musky, melonladen sweet muscat has just the right amount of leafy bitterness to offset the liqueur-like density of grape sugars. Such precise aromatics are rare in sweet Muscat.

Tasting Notes:

A supple core of plum, dark raisin and black currant presents itself under layers of savory cocoa, black licorice, and earth. Dark, extracted fruit, subdued acidity and mellow, powdery tannins propel this broodingly rich red.

Domaine Treloar One Block Muscat 2013 Cotes Catalanes, 13% abv

90 Excellent, Highly Recommended

Tasting Notes:

A complex set of aromas includes orange blossom, almonds, and white honeysuckle blossoms. Dry on the palate the flavors burst with yellow peach, lemon zest, white flowers and a touch of grassiness. The flavors are well balanced and long lasting.
